Purple turnips, mixed greens and arugula through the winter! We sell other produce from local farmers, and are very selective of that produce. Consumers can buy the produce on Rt.6A in Dennis. Market pricing. Market opens at 10am, closes at 6pm, all week. We have a salad club, where people pick up produce once a week that is pre-bagged. \$216-\$306 for 18 weeks of salad, picked up once a week. Nonprofit organization employing adults with disabilities.
